INTRODUCTION

- **Q4/21 marked the beginning of HIV Reporting under the support of AAA.**
- **The services provided focused on Health Testing Services (HTS), Antiretroviral Therapy (ART), Prevention of Mother to Child Transmission (PMTCT) and Exposed Infants Diagnosis(EID).**
- **Although majority of facilities did not manage to submit their reports due to challenges such as lack of HIV reporting tools, 41 health facilities in Lakes, NBG, WBG and Warrap delivered on time.**
- **AAA Recognizes that access to HIV services and support is critical to quality health and education on HIV Prevention and Care.**
- **AAA continues to collaborate efforts to minimize the challenges towards holistic care.**

DATA ISSUES ENCOUNTERED DURING REPORTING

- Increased error rate was a hindrance to quality data.
- Inconsistency in data provided was time consuming especially in correction of errors and missing values.
- Mistype on reporting date increased chances of disorganization, inaccuracy, and misinformation.
- Different reporting formats and incorrect formatting increased discrepancies.
- Numerous indicators.
- Errors in input process especially in the ART Report negatively affected the quality of data.
- Gaps in data transmission.
- Duplicate registry of information.

SOLUTIONS TO ENCOUNTERED ISSUES

- **Persons in charge of entries at the facility should be knowledgeable on reporting format and instructions for entries. AAA will keep mentoring the incharge at the HFs to ensure quality reporting.**
- **It is crucial to double check values, reporting dates to minimize errors and duplication.**
- **Provide reports as soon as data is keyed in to avoid last minute rush and high chances of inaccuracy.**
- **Promote routine chart review linked with patient tracking.**

CONCLUSION

- **AAA is committed to improving the quality of life by minimizing disparities in access to HIV services.**
- **Indeed, many of the challenges that undermine data accuracy were related to the processes and context of data collection. AAA is committed to identify loopholes and aid in smoothening the processes involved.**
- **Despite the challenges, the new patients recorded in the quarter are proof of access to care.**
- **To guarantee action-focused information, timely and accurate, data must be availed to guarantee improvement and quality care for new and old patients in the health facilities.**
